This includes the handbook (cover to cover), the newsletters, the bulletin board, and all handouts placed in your family's mailbox. WHY? Communications are difficult in a large group, so each person must take the responsibility to keep themselves informed by reading everything that is put out.

Be On Time.

Your workday starts at 9 a.m. You should be 5 minutes early, so you can chat with other parents and still have the school all set up by 9:25 a.m. WHY? If your attention is on the set-up process, it cannot be 100% on the arriving and playing children you are there to assist.

Always Know When You Are Scheduled To Work.

Either parent is welcome to be the participating parent.

Be Available on Your Alternate Day.

This is a firm commitment.

Bring and Pick up Children on Time.

School starts at 9:30 a.m. and ends at 12:30 p.m. (12:00 noon on rainy days) Fees will be charged for children who are left early or not picked up on time.

Attend Membership Meetings.

These are generally held on the first Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. (or as announced). Attendance at the September meeting is essential.

Smile and Be Friendly.

Be Willing to Accept Responsibility.

Be an active committee member. Fund-raiser participation is required. Sign up early and help willingly.

Share Talents and Abilities.

Willingness to try is a talent.

Enjoy the Children...not just your child.

Bring Questions, Concerns and Suggestions to the (Co) Directors or Board.

Where action, not gossip, can result.

Check Your Mailbox and Bulletin Board Often.

Pay Your Fees by the 10th of the Month.
